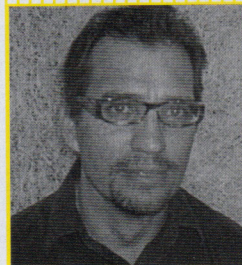
XAL: Minimal

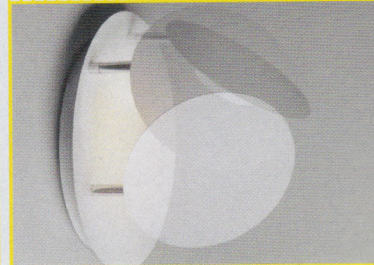

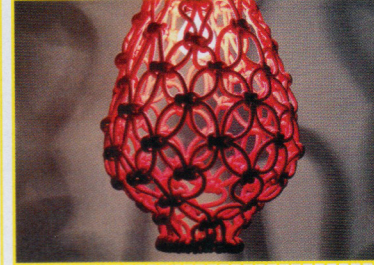

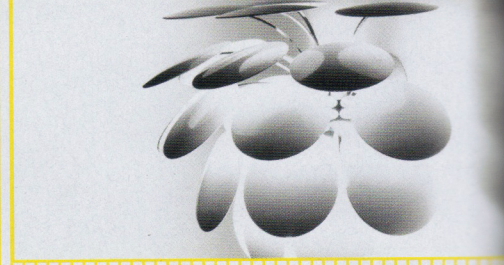
