

GOING GLOBAL RARE CHANCE IN THE SWISS ALPS

Owning your own place in the Swiss Alps just got a lot easier. Purchase restrictions have been lifted in the new fully integrated five-star village, **Andermatt Swiss Alps**, opening the doors for 800 buyers.

And life will not be limited to swooshing down the slopes, as the village will offer year-round living, including an 18-hole golf course, horseback riding, paragliding and snowshoeing activities. Pricing tops out at US \$60 million for villas, US \$17 million for penthouses, US \$8 million for apartments, and US \$4.5 million for condominiums.

"For the first time in history, the Swiss government, in seeing the value of this resort to Switzerland, granted a purchase exemption," said Barbara Young, president of Henley Estates USA.

Within Andermatt, a former Swiss military center, Orascom Development Holding AG envisioned a high-end destination resort and secured an exemption to the Lex Koller law, which limits property purchases by foreigners.

"We believe in the lifestyle of Andermatt Swiss Alps — high-end luxury experiences with all-season sports and cultural activities," says Tony Young of Henley Estates USA. "We are pleased to invite the world to own a piece of Andermatt Swiss Alps."
